The 30th Annual Mohawk Valley Independence Day Parade Committee invites you to participate in our 2002 Parade. For those of you who participated in last years parade, we again thank you for being a part of this area event. If you won an award and did not pick it up at the Park, the award is available at the Eastern Plumas Chamber of Commerce office.

Our Parade is held the first Sunday of July. This year the first Sunday is July 7th.

Our Parade is informal and hosts anywhere from 50 to 70 entries. If you know of someone who would like to participate in our parade, please have them contact us.

Our theme this year is "RED, WHITE AND BLUE IN 2002" We hope that you can incorporate the theme in your entry with decorations, costumes, or music. Extra Judging Points will be given to entries using the themes.

Enclosed is the Parade Entry Form and the Rules and Regulations. Registration will begin at 11:30 AM in Goldridge Estates. Please return the forms with your check for the \$10.00 entry fee by June 16th to assure a listing in the program.

On Sunday July 7th, you can start your morning with a Pancake Breakfast sponsored by the Graeagle Volunteer Fire Department, from 8 AM to 11 AM at the Graeagle Firehall, participate in the parade, and then enjoy the Festival in Park following the Parade which will include a BBQ, live music and activities for children. On Saturday July 6th, Our SPECTACULAR AERIAL FIREWORKS SHOW at the Graeagle Millpond will begin at dusk (approximately 9:30 PM).

SUNDAY JULY 7th
RULES AND REGULATIONS

- DEADLINE June 16th for program listing.
- ENTRY FEE \$10.00
- THEME Red, White and Blue in 2002
- ASSEMBLY Registration and assembly will start at 11:30 AM, Goldridge Estates (Hwy A14), Blairsden, one-half mile off Highway 89.
- STARTING TIME Parade will start promptly at 1:00 PM.
- VEHICLES Modern cars or trucks will not be eligible to win unless they are decorated as a float.
- NUMBERS Entry numbers will be placed on the **LEFT SIDE OF THE ENTRY** for judging.
- JUDGING Judging will be done on an informal basis by selected persons from the community and decisions will be final. Everyone who participates in our parade is a potential winner. **CONSIDERATION WILL BE MADE TO THOSE WHO HAVE INCORPORATED THE THEME in their entry decorating.**
- AWARDS Will be announced in the Park as soon as the judging is completed. (Approximately 3:00 PM). Awards not presented at the Park may be picked up at the Eastern Plumas Chamber of Commerce or arrangements will be made to mail them.
- DISPERSAL Entries will maintain the order of march as assigned at the assemble area. **DO NOT STOP OR LEAVE THE PARADE LINE UNTIL YOU REACH THE DISPERSAL AREA.**
- SAFETY THERE WILL BE NO THROWING OF CANDY OR OTHER ARTICLES FROM THE PARADE ENTRIES. The throwing of any item, including water, causes a safety hazard to children and violates our permit agreement with the highway departments and our insurance. We all miss this, but endangering kids and the liability suits make it a thing of the past. **ITEMS MAY BE HANDED** to the crowd from the entries walking along the edge of the crowd line as long as it does not cause the crowd to come out into the roadway and path of the parade.
- NOW HEAR THIS – ANYONE SEEN SQUIRTING WATER OR THROWING CANDY, ETC. WILL BE PULLED OUT OF THE PARADE BY THE MARSHALS ON THE SPOT.**
